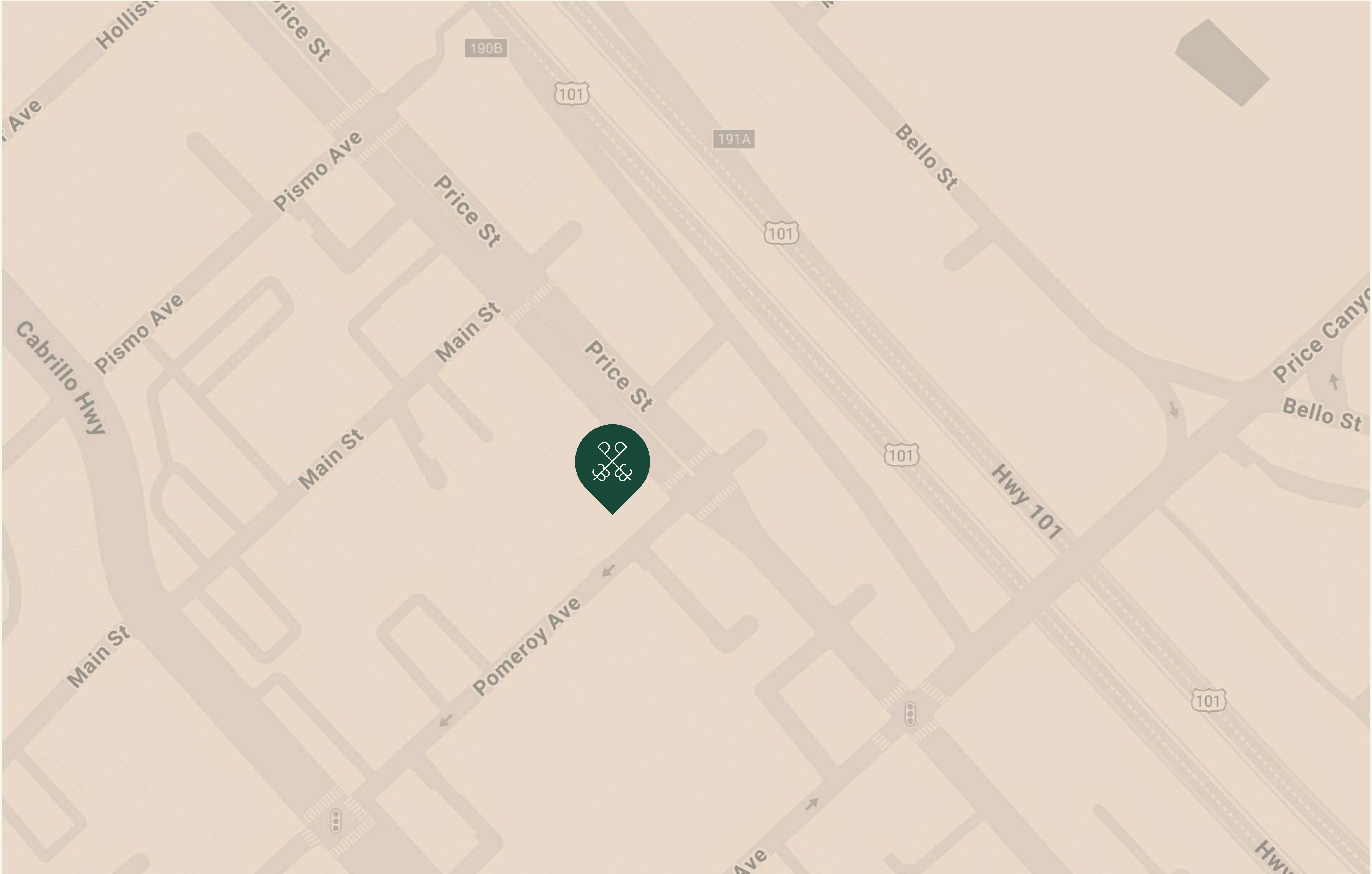

ARRIVAL



NORTHBOUND:

1. Take Exit 190 for Price Street / Hinds Avenue.
2. Continue straight on Price Street for .3 miles
3. Arrive at 701 Price Street on the left side of the street

*To reach the parking lot continue straight and make a u-turn at Main Street. Turn right into the parking lot just before Pomeroy Ave.

SOUTHBOUND:

1. Take Exit 191B for Price Street / Shell Beach Road / CA-1 South.
2. Merge onto Price Street and continue south for approximately 1.5 miles.
3. Arrive at 701 Price Street, which will be on your right. (Turn right into the parking lot just before Pomeroy Ave)

PARKING

PRIOR TO ARRIVAL:

To reserve parking, please message one of our communications agents through your booking platform, or text or call us at 805.586.0080.

Parking is \$30 per vehicle per day, and spaces are assigned upon reservation. If you booked directly through our website — which we recommend for the best rates and service — any messages will be sent to the phone number or email address you provided.

PARKING ACCESS:

Our parking lot is only accessible from the southbound side of Price Street. If you're heading north, you can make a safe U-turn or loop around by taking Pomeroy Avenue, then Cabrillo Highway, Main Street, and back onto Price Street.

AT HOTEL:

Parking is a \$30 per-day fee, charged through our app. We allow one car per room. Please text us at 805-586-0080 for the parking app link—you can also pay during your pre-check-in.

STREET PARKING:

Metered street parking is available along Price Street and in the surrounding area. Please note that parking may be subject to local time limits and city regulations.

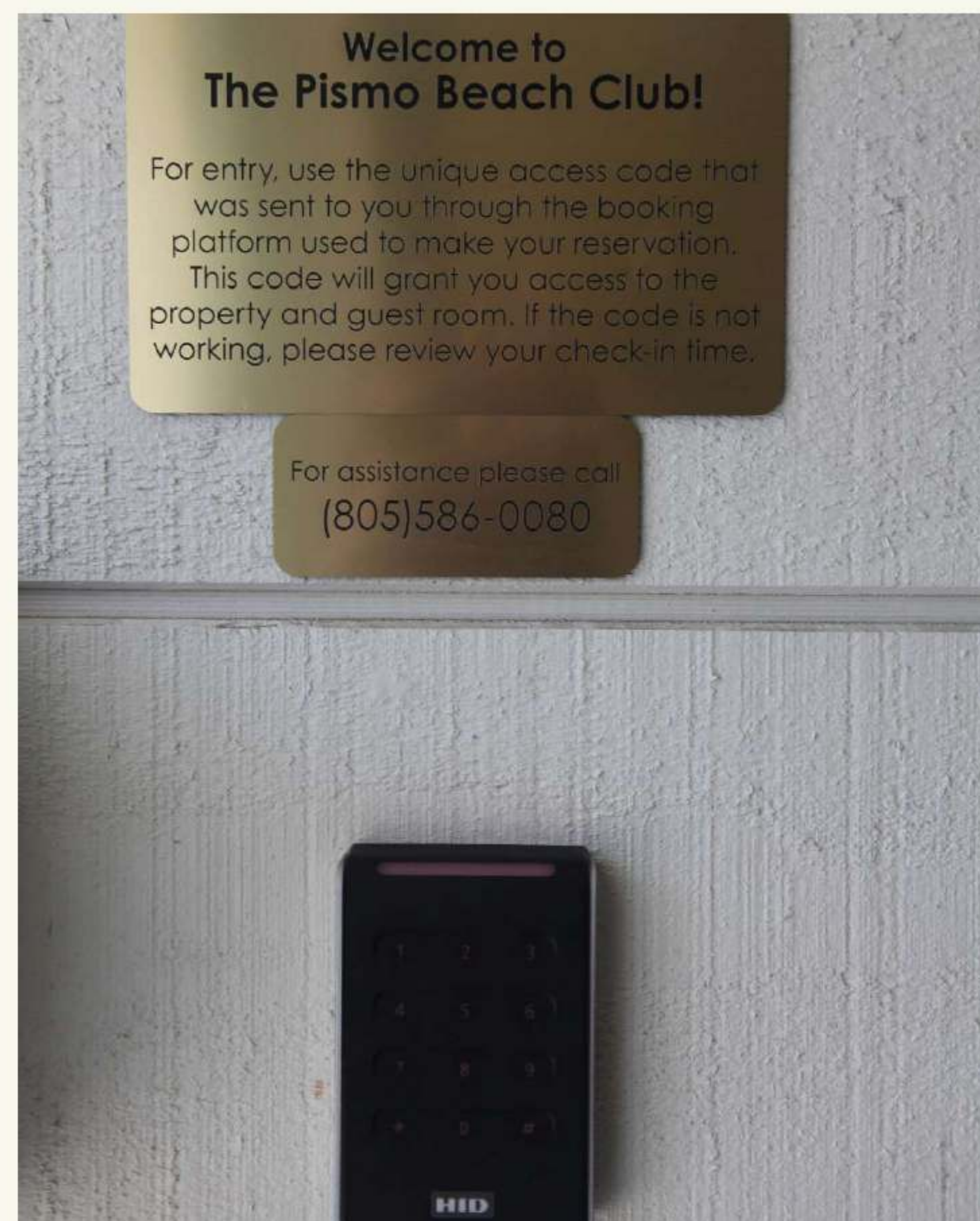
If you haven't received your code, please text us at 805.586.0080.

If the lock beeps twice, the code was entered incorrectly. After three incorrect attempts, the lock will temporarily disable for two minutes before you can try again.

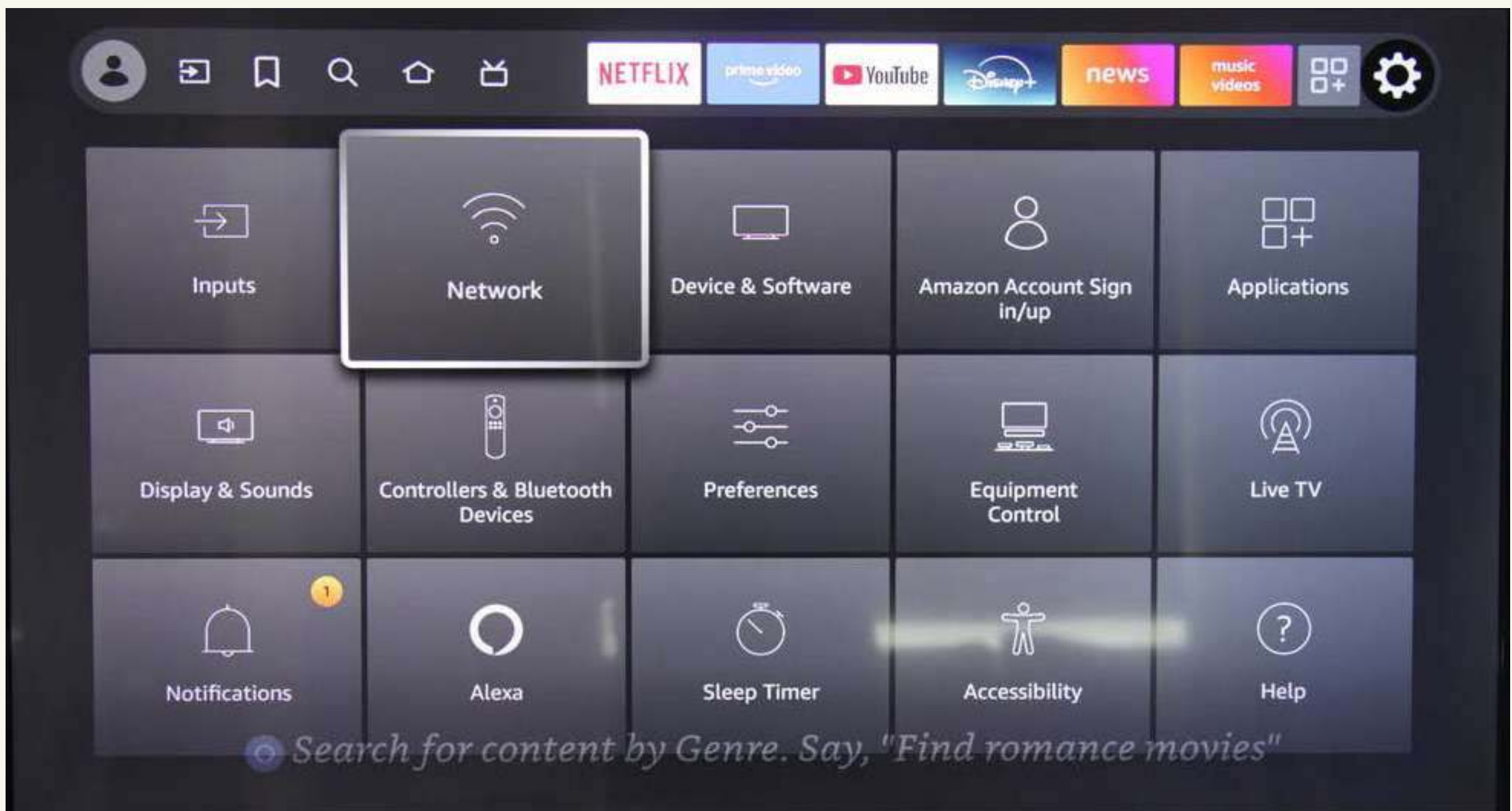
- If a sign-in screen appears, press the Back button on your remote to exit.

The TV should now be connected. Feel free to log in to your personal accounts on streaming apps like Netflix, Hulu, and more.

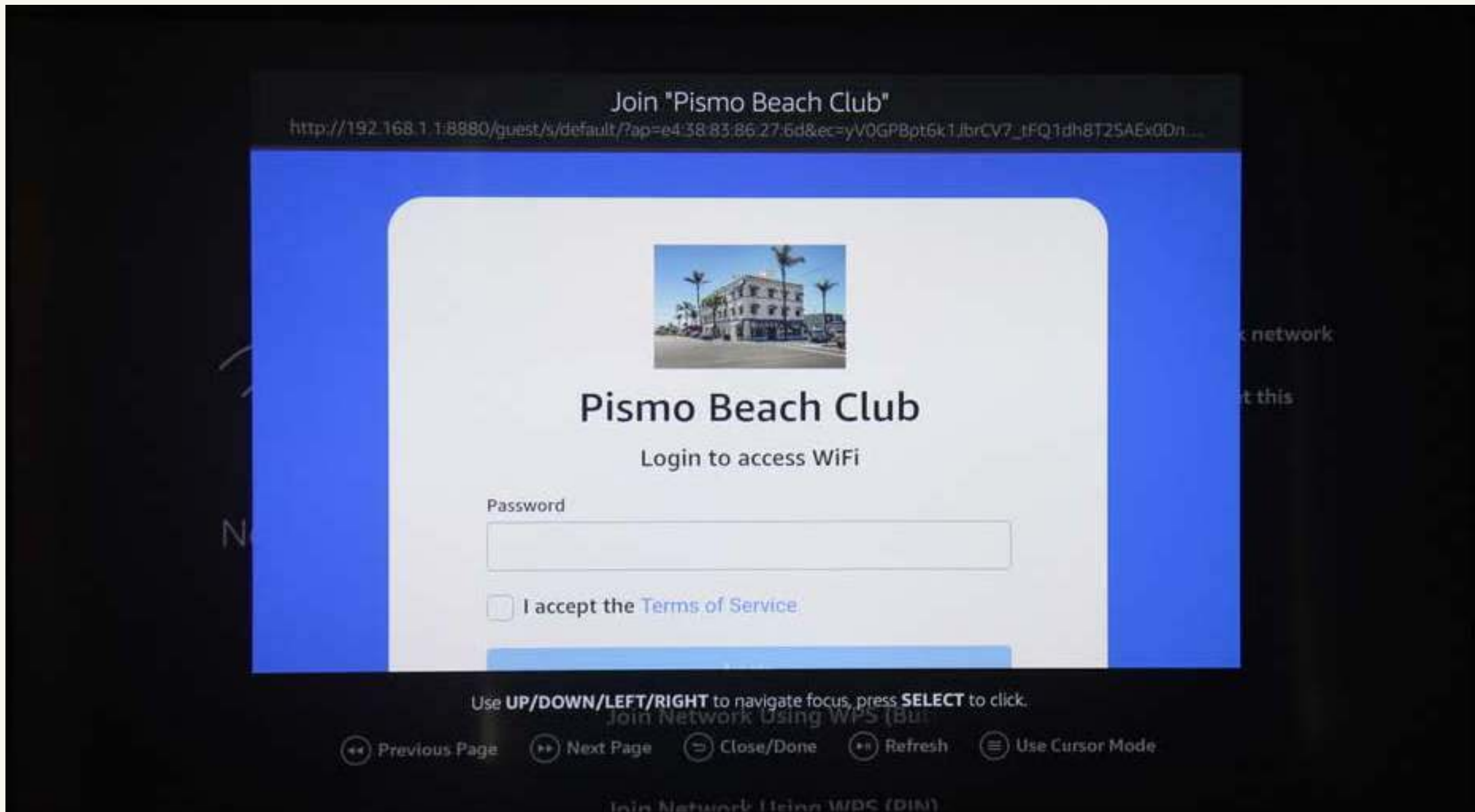

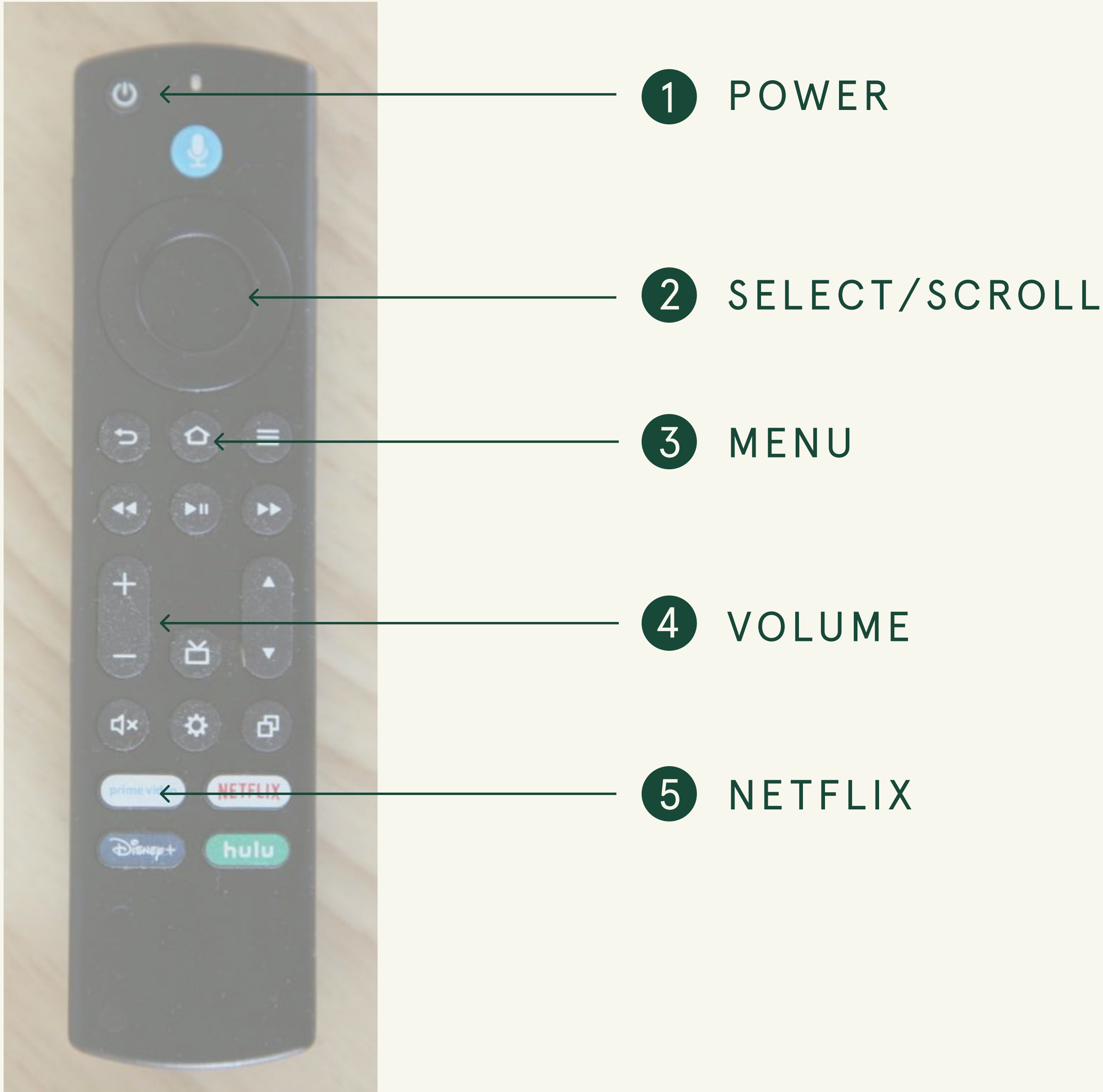
TEMPERATURE & REMOTE

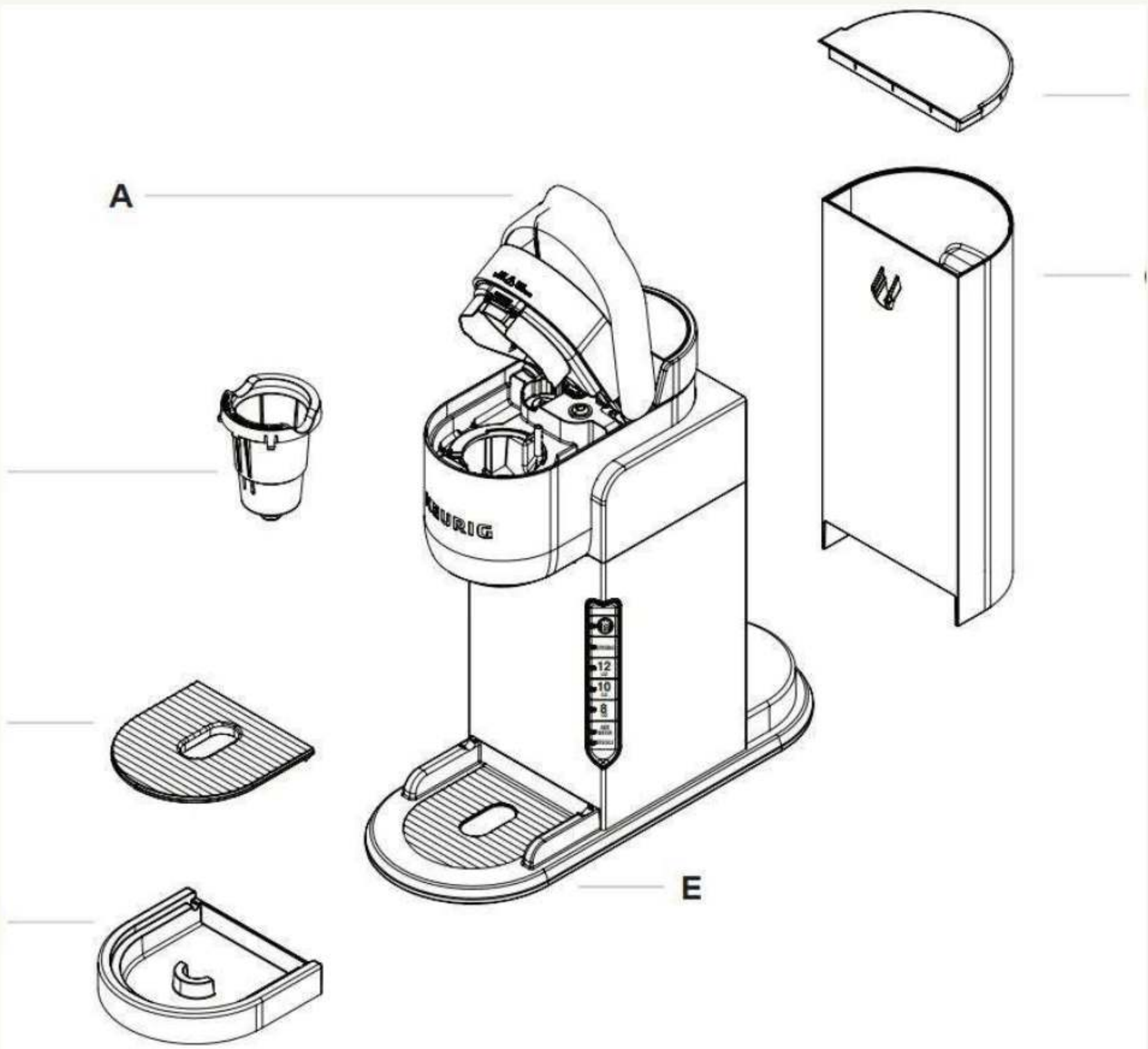
How to Use the Nespresso Machine:

- Fill the Water Tank – Ensure the water reservoir at the back of the machine is filled with fresh water.
- Turn on the Machine – Press the power button and wait for the lights to stop blinking, indicating the machine is heated and ready.
- Insert a Capsule – Lift the lever, place a Nespresso coffee capsule into the compartment, and close the lever securely.
- Start Brewing – Press the brew button to begin the coffee-making process.
- Enjoy Your Coffee – Once the coffee is dispensed, remove your cup and savor your fresh brew.
- Dispose of the Used Capsule – Lift the lever again to eject the used capsule into the capsule container.
- Turn Off the Machine – The machine will power off automatically, but you can also turn it off manually if needed.

ICE

There is an ice machine located in the laundry room on the first floor across from the elevator. An ice bucket has been provided for you in the freezer of your room. There is also an ice tray located inside the freezer within the fridge.



STOVE

Using the 2-Burner Electric Cooktop

- 1. Place a dry, flat-bottomed pan on the burner.
- 2. Turn the knob clockwise to start and adjust the heat—the farther you turn, the hotter it gets.
- 3. The red light next to the knob indicates the burner is on and hot.
- 4. Only place cookware on the burner while it’s on.
- 5. Turn the knob to OFF when finished and allow the burner to cool before cleaning.

Safety tips: Never leave the stove unattended, keep flammable items away, and contact the front desk at (805) 586-0080 with any issues.

DISHWASHER

Dishwasher pods are located next to the kitchen sink in a glass container. These are to be used with the dish washer accordingly. Refer to settings listed here.

OVEN

Turn the knob clockwise to increase heat. The burner cycles between OFF and full power—the more you turn it, the hotter it gets. A red light next to each knob turns on when that burner is ON and hot.

Don't put anything (except cookware) on the burner while the red light is on—it's too hot to touch.



COOKING MODES

Oven Light: Turns the oven light on when selected.

Broil: Best for melting cheese, toasting and browning. For optimal results, use in conjunction with the Broil temperature setting.

Fan Grill: Utilizes a high heat grilling element and fan to circulate hot air throughout the oven. Ideal for cooking large cuts of meats so that they are moist inside and crisp on the outside. Use a thermometer to check the internal temperature. It is recommended to set the temperature no higher than 400°F.

Convection Cooking: Utilizes the powerful heating element surrounding the fan to evenly distribute heat throughout the oven. This is great for multi-shelf cooking because the fan ensures each rack is heated.

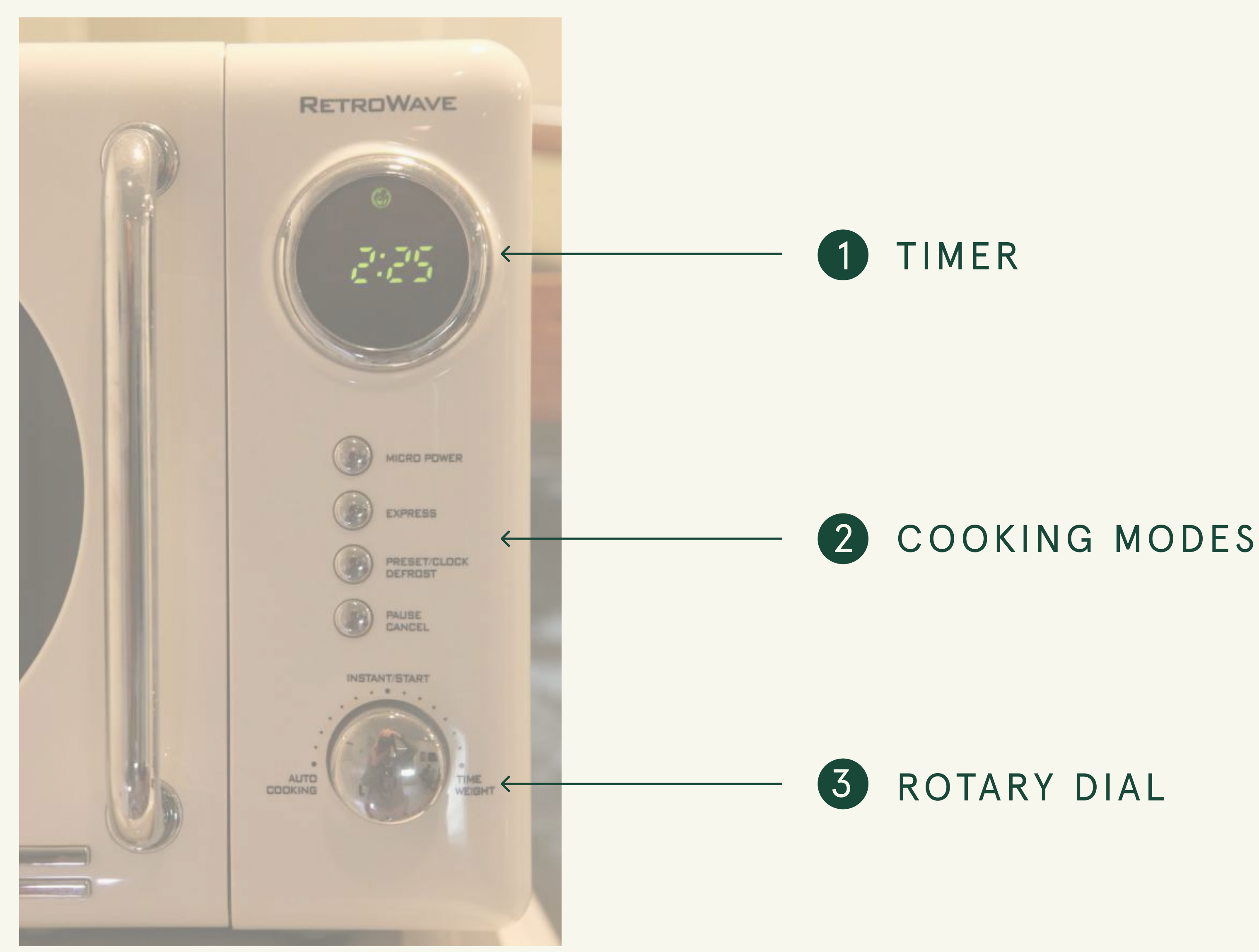
Defrost: Circulates air at room temperature to defrost food. For foods such as meat, fish, and bread, Convection Cooking Mode, set between 175°–225°F, can be used to accelerate the defrosting process.



MICROWAVE

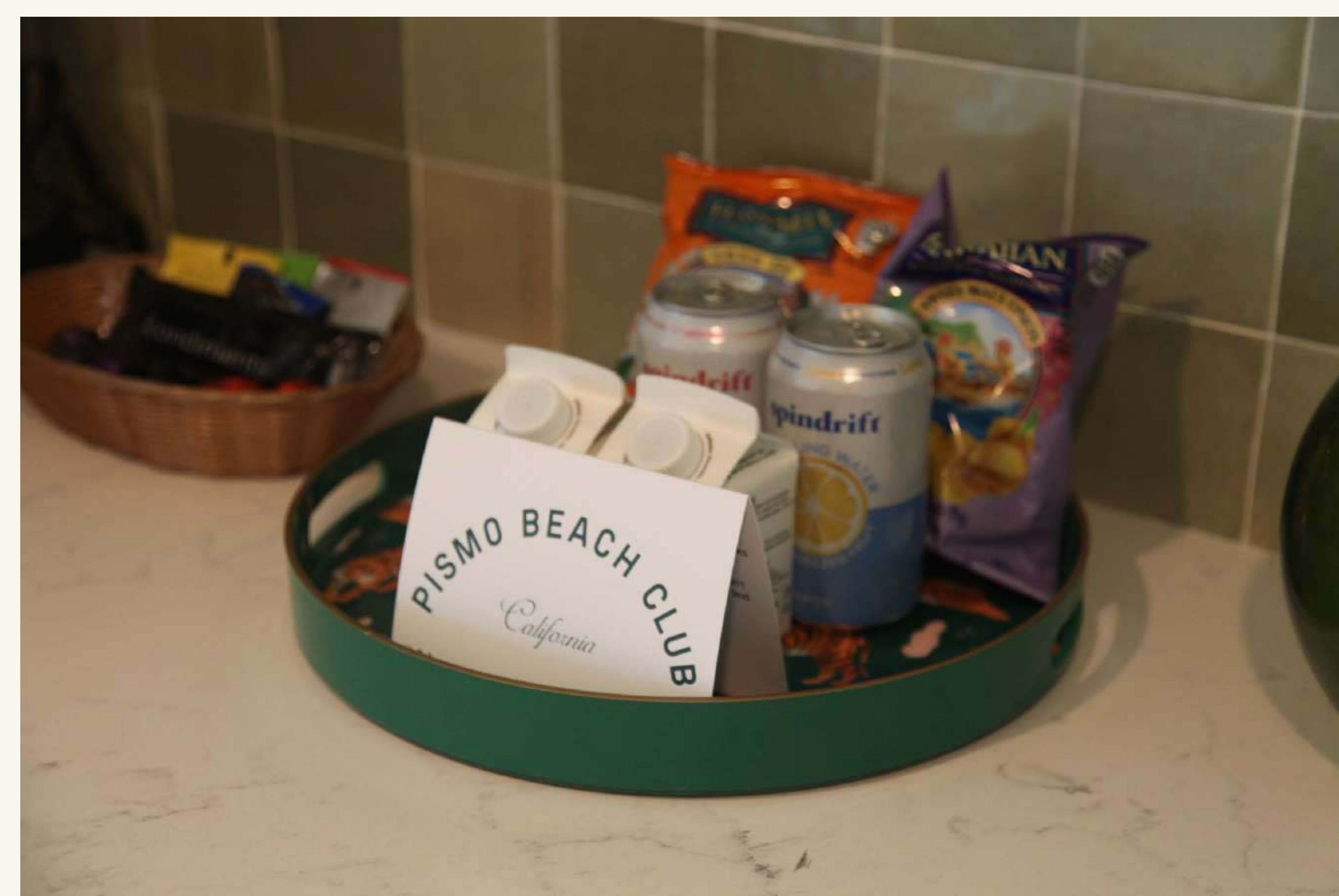
Open the Door

- Pull the handle to open the microwave door.
- Put your food on a microwave-safe plate or container.
- Close the door securely.
- Set the Cooking Time
- Use the rotary dial to set the time (turn clockwise).
- For example, turn to 1:00 for 1 minute.
- Press the START button to begin heating.
- The microwave will automatically start and count down.
- Press STOP/CANCEL to pause or stop the microwave at any time.
- When done, the microwave will beep.
- Carefully open the door and take out your food –it may be hot!



SNACKS & SPARKLING WATER

All the snacks and sparkling waters on the tray in the kitchen are complimentary—please help yourself and enjoy! We love treating our guests to a few extra comforts during their stay.



LAUNDRY

Our laundry room is located on the first floor across from the elevator. It is available to guests 24/7.

Using the Washer and Dryer:

Both the Speed Queen washer and dryer accept credit card payment via the built-in pay range.

Washer: Load laundry, add detergent (provided on the extras shelf next to the ice machine), select a cycle (Normal, Heavy, or Delicate) and water temperature, then close the door to start automatically (30–50 min).

Dryer: Transfer clothes, select a cycle and temperature, then close the door to start automatically (30–60 min).

Tips: Don't overload the machines, and be sure to collect all belongings — the hotel is not responsible for lost or damaged items.

HISTORY OF PISMO



Pismo Beach, nestled along California's Central Coast, boasts a rich and fascinating history that dates back thousands of years.

The region was originally home to the Chumash people, who thrived along the coastline for centuries, relying on the abundant marine life and natural resources. The name "Pismo" is derived from the Chumash word Pismo, meaning "tar," referring to the natural tar springs found in the area, which the Chumash used to waterproof their canoes and other tools.

In the late 1700s, Spanish explorers arrived, and the land later became part of a Mexican land grant known as Rancho Pismo. After California became a U.S. state in 1850, the area began to attract settlers, and in 1881, John Michael Price, one of the early pioneers, founded the town of Pismo Beach, recognizing its potential as a seaside resort.



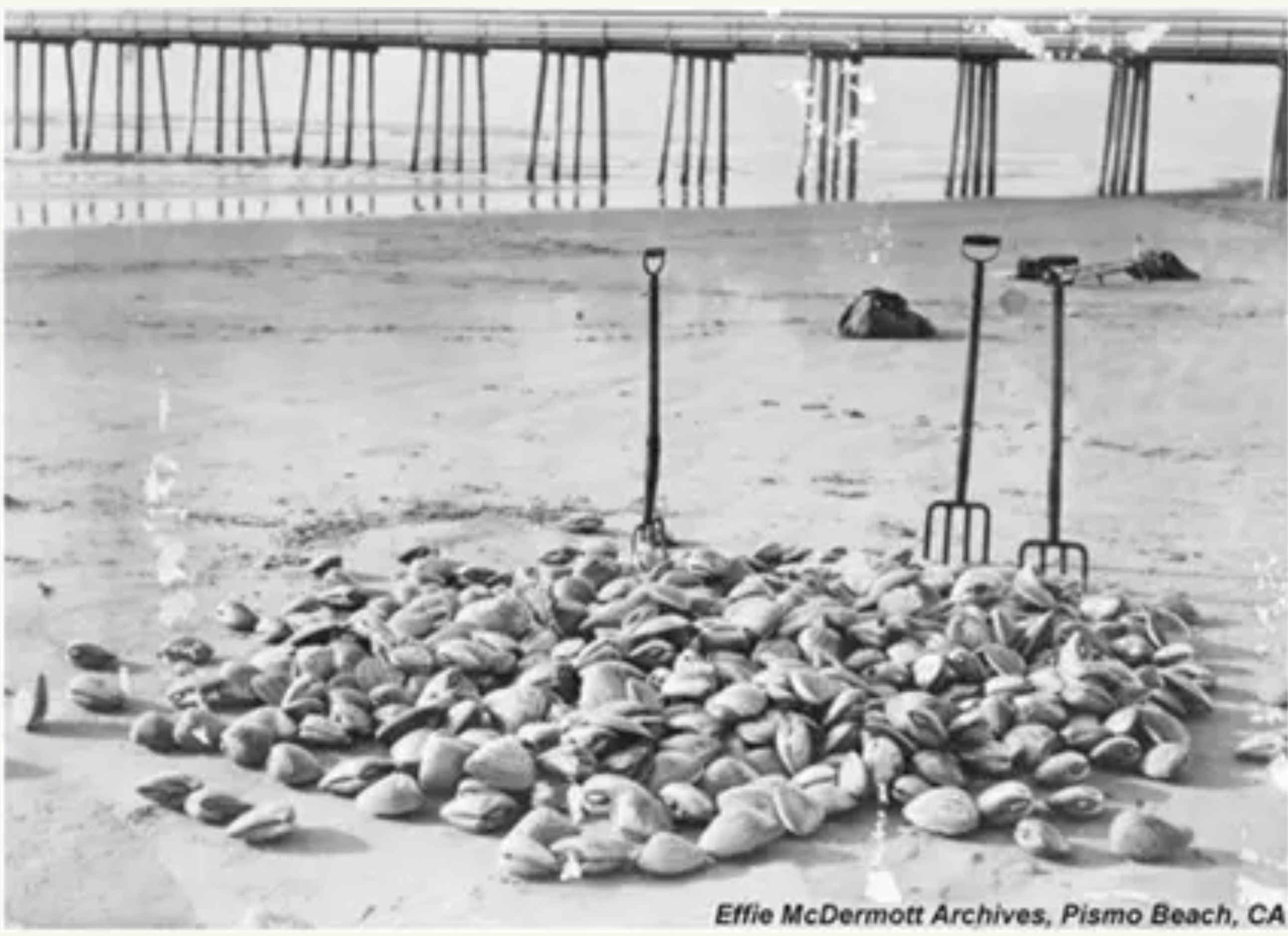

By the early 20th century, Pismo Beach had developed into a popular vacation destination, known for its expansive sandy shores and the famous Pismo clams, which were once so abundant that the town became known as the "Clam Capital of the World."

The construction of the Pismo Pier in 1924 further cemented its reputation as a prime tourist spot, drawing visitors for fishing, beachside recreation, and scenic ocean views. Over time, as tourism grew, the town saw the development of hotels, restaurants, and attractions catering to travelers seeking a relaxing coastal retreat.

While commercial clam digging has declined due to conservation efforts, the town continues to celebrate its heritage with the annual Pismo Beach Clam Festival, a tradition dating back to 1946.

Today, Pismo Beach maintains its charm as a quintessential California beach town, blending history, natural beauty, and a welcoming atmosphere that continues to attract visitors from all over.

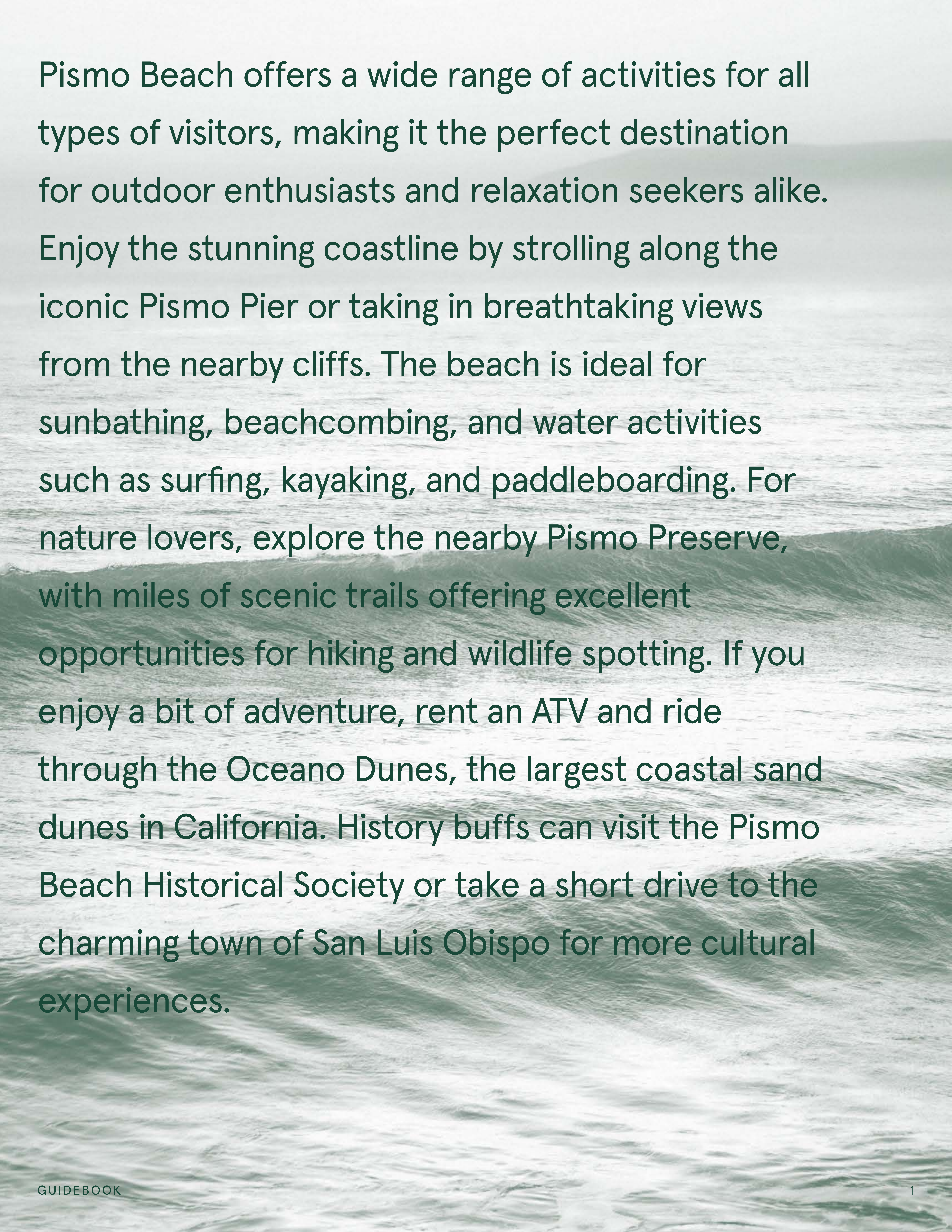

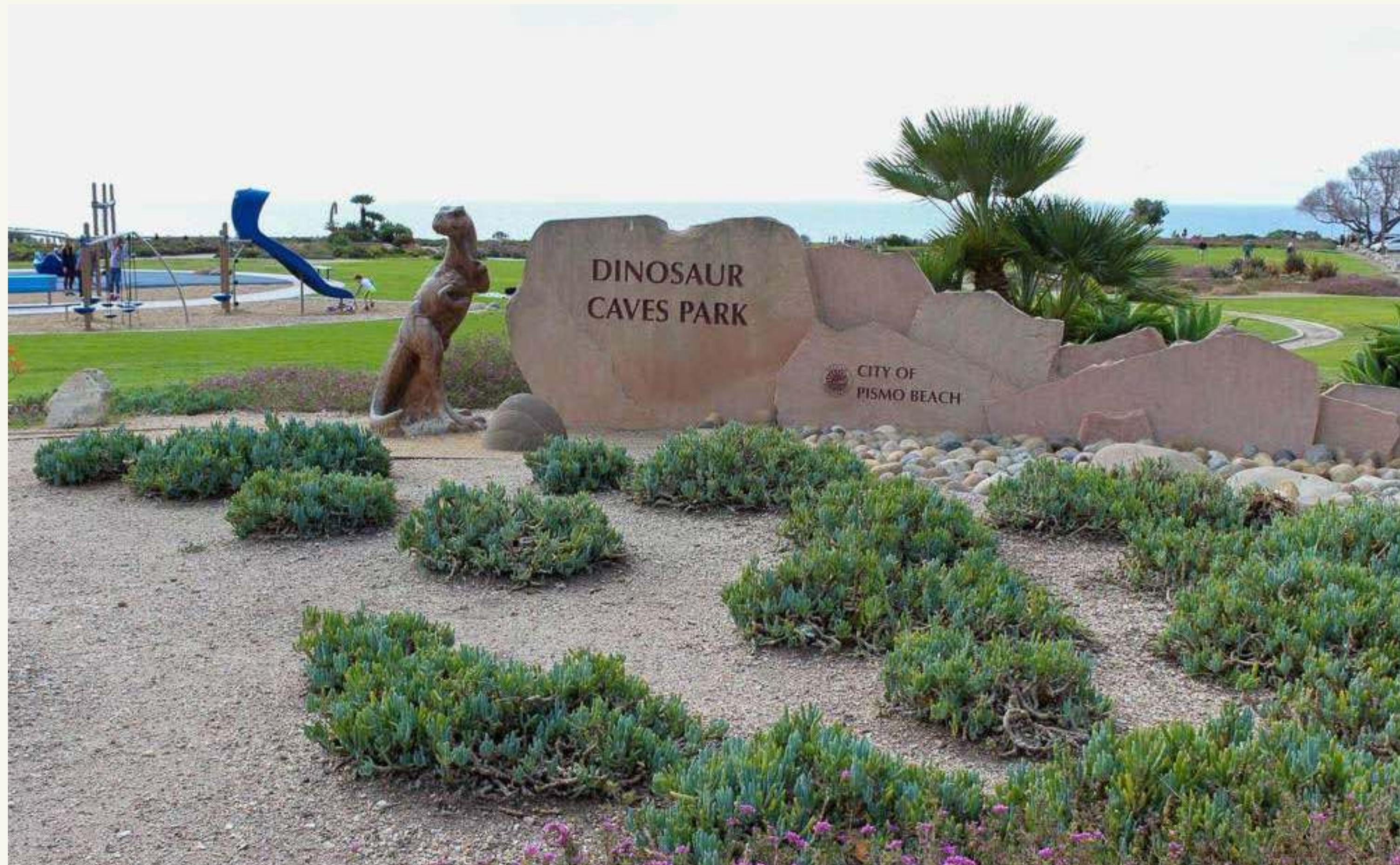

OCEANO BEACH

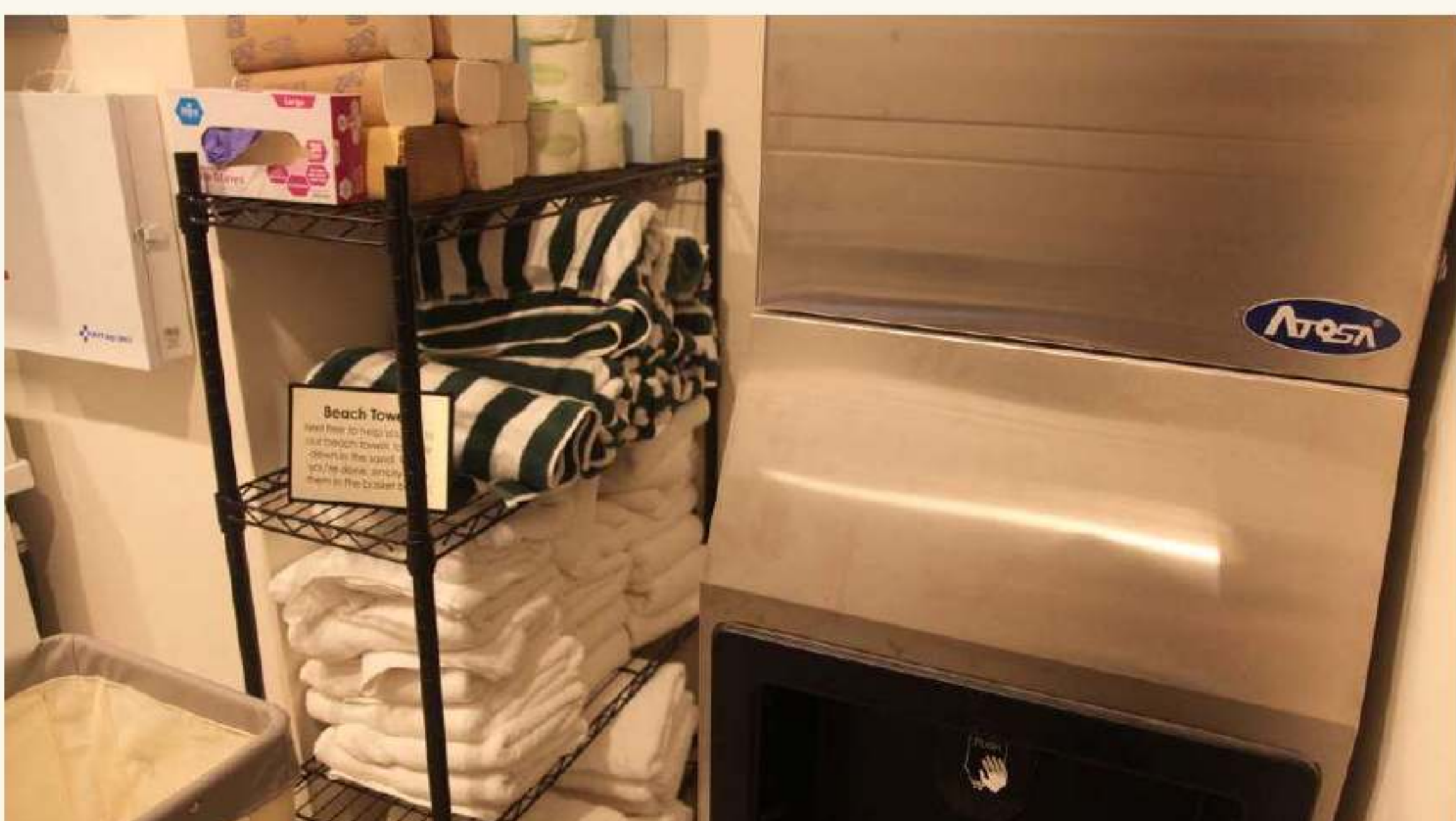

About 45 minutes south, the Santa Ynez Valley opens up around the charming towns of Los Olivos, Solvang, and Ballard Canyon—known for Rhône varietals, Syrah, and world-class tasting rooms. Whether you have an afternoon or a full day, here are our favorite wineries and tasting rooms to explore.

DAY TRIP ITINERARY

SANTA YNEZ VALLEY DAY TRIP

MORNING

Start your day with a scenic drive from Pismo Beach to the Santa Ynez Valley, about 40–45 minutes. Once you arrive, head to Solvang, a charming Danish-inspired town, for a leisurely breakfast. Stop by Mortensen's Danish Bakery for freshly baked pastries or grab a warm breakfast sandwich at Solvang Restaurant, then stroll through Solvang's quaint streets, shops, and galleries.

Next, head to Epiphany Cellars in the heart of downtown Los Olivos—one of Santa Barbara County's premier producers of Rhône varietals, with a spacious garden courtyard that's ideal for a relaxed, seated tasting. Then make a short drive to Stolpman Vineyards in Ballard Canyon, known for its Rhône varietals and limestone-rich soils, with panoramic vineyard views and estate Syrah and Grenache.

LATE MORNING

(Optional) Continue to Tercero Wines or the Liquid Farm Tasting Room, both in Los Olivos. Tercero offers small-lot Rhône and Loire-inspired varietals, while Liquid Farm's sunny, farmhouse-style room is perfect for relaxing over boutique Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

LUNCH

Make your way into Los Olivos for lunch. For a quick, casual bite, Panino (2900 Grand Ave) is a local favorite for Italian-inspired sandwiches, soups, and salads—grab one for the patio or take it to a nearby tasting room. For a sit-down meal, The Los Olivos Wine Merchant & Cafe serves Mediterranean-inspired dishes paired perfectly with local wines.

AFTERNOON

After lunch, visit Fess Parker Winery & Vineyard, just outside Los Olivos on the Foxen Canyon Wine Trail. Known for its estate Rhône varietals, Sta. Rita Hills Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, and beautiful grounds, Fess Parker offers a laid-back tasting on its scenic veranda.

Finish your main wine journey at Sunstone Winery in Santa Ynez. This organic estate feels like the Provençal countryside, with stone courtyards, barrel-aging caves, and expansive picnic grounds—the perfect place for a relaxing walk and a final tasting.

LATE AFTERNOON / EARLY EVENING

Extend your tasting with a few satellite wine bar stops:

- Lo-Fi Wines in Los Alamos — a casual room specializing in natural wines.
- Potek Winery in Santa Barbara — a trendy downtown tasting room and winemaking studio.
- Kunin Wines in Santa Barbara — small-lot Rhône and Loire varietals in a historic downtown location, ideal for a final stop before heading back.

EVENING

On your way back to Pismo Beach, stop in Buellton for dinner at The Hitching Post II, famous for its oak-grilled steaks and Central Coast wines. It's the perfect way to conclude a full day of wine tasting in the Santa Ynez Valley.
